

Intercession and Supplication Guide 2024

Times of Victories, Warnings, Unity, Surrender, Protection and Faithfulness

Introduction:

This year of presidential elections in the United States is one of wars, uncertainties, difficulties and world changes. Still, the church is preparing for a great harvest of souls who will receive the gospel and our family in Christ is growing with joy. We will have victories, but with warnings to beware of contamination. God will surprise us with unity of revelation, as He asks us for a complete surrender, where we will see His protection in the midst of adversity. He is always FAITHFUL. Now it is up to us to demonstrate our faithfulness, in humility, submitted to obedience.

Jeremiah 29:11

For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Supplication 1 Seeking the Face of the Lord

John 4:23-24

23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. 24 God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.”

Introduction:

Now more than ever it is necessary for us to encounter the Face of our Lord in humility and complete submission. The best way to find Him is to be found by Him. He seeks those who worship Him in Spirit and in Truth. In this Supplication we focus on our faithfulness to God, knowing that He is already faithful. It's up to us to be faithful. During the prayer God gave a vision of a hand with a sword with words on either side that said, Faithfulness and Surrender.

Psalm 51:17 My sacrifice, O God, is^{al} a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart you, God, will not despise.

Repentance and humility:

- We repent for being fickle in prayer.
- We repent for lacking sincerity and self-sacrifice in worship. For erecting empty altars without an offering.
- We repent for lacking faithfulness to your word.
- We repent for being indifferent to the congregation, ministry, and place of worship where you have placed us

Proverbs 7:1-3

My son, keep my words and store up my commands within you. Keep my commands and you will live; guard my teachings as the apple of your eye. Bind them on your fingers; write them on the tablet of your heart.

Supplications:

- We supplicate for a genuine, holy spirit of worship, in the manner of God.
- We submit every man-made idea of worship, or our own opinions.
- We acknowledge that you are God, unique, true, all-powerful, majestic, DESERVING of all exaltation. We exalt the name, the greatest of all names.
- We submit our actions to God in obedience. Every church program, staff, and action we take is subject to God's approval.
- We supplicate for the desire to fulfill first and foremost the will of the heavenly Father. To demonstrate that he is the Lord of our life, the center of our being.
- We supplicate for the ability to have absolute confidence in him,

Declarations;

- We declare that we will have a peace and security that only God gives.
- We declare God, King and Lord of our lives and that our plans are His.
- We declare that we submit to God's will, His glory, and honor.
- We declare spiritual victories, in the joy of knowing that God is doing His work in us.

Romans 12:2

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Supplication 2: Identity and Strength

2 Corinthians 5:20-21

We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Introduction:

As revealed during our prayer of supplication, times of difficulty are coming, just because we are ambassadors for Christ. Obstacles will arise in areas and places that were previously easy for us to visit. On the other hand, we will see miracles. God will open doors, paths, and move mountains. The church has an identity of its own based on Jesus. His word, it does not bend or sell out, therefore it is hated by the governments of man.

Supplication:

- We supplicate for divine strength. Direction from the Holy Spirit intones the action of ministering, preaching, and carrying on God's work.
- We supplicate for laborers in the great harvest that has already begun.
- We supplicate that we may not be a stumbling block amid this harvest. That we may be facilitators of the work.

- We supplicate for God to reveal areas to us to plant in offerings, prayers, help, ministry support, and ministry council.
- We supplicate for leaders who are mature, worthy, exemplary, humble, and fit for the work.
- We supplicate that by identifying ourselves as ambassadors, we represent Christ and we will be filled with the authority, ability, and power that an ambassador possesses according to God's will.

Declarations:

- We declare that in times of adversity in our ministries, we do not lose heart. God is our strength.
- We declare according to Psalm 46:1, God is our refuge and strength, our quick help in tribulations.
- We declare that amid personal difficulties we do not faint, God will do miraculous works in our families.
- We declare victory over every condition of emotional depression, discouragement, and exhaustion.

Philippians 4:11-13 I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through him who gives me strength.

Supplication 3 Wisdom in the Midst of the Ages

1 Chronicles 12:32

from Issachar, men who understood the times and knew what Israel should do—200 chiefs, with all their relatives under their command;

Introduction:

God provided Israel with men who could understand the times and even more so, provide wisdom on how to proceed in the midst of their times. Today we are more than blessed by the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives who reveals to us the things to come.

John 16:13

But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

In our prayer meeting, God showed the figure of a bull tied by its horns, straining to get out but unable to do so. We understand that this time is important because it is a year of presidential and other elections. Although many of these visions may have specific meanings, we understand that only God allows events to happen that affect nations and the times belong to God. There are forces antagonistic to the gospel, Christians, and God's work. These times will be of uncertainty for those who walk halfway. We, on the other hand, know that God is ALMIGHTY. There is no fear, we only trust in our God.

Supplications:

- We supplicate for wisdom amid changes, laws, and government decisions that run counter to God's truth.
- We supplicate for God's strategies to His children amid economic changes, and for provision.
- We supplicate for wisdom to the church during attacks from other anti-Christian organizations.
- Supplicate for protection and wisdom for government officials who love the gospel and are ambassadors for Christ amid their careers and roles.
- We supplicate for protection and peace during the 2024 presidential elections. During confusion, may God bring clarity and understanding.
- We supplicate for peace among Christians so that they can be an example and a light during elections.
- We supplicate for wisdom to God's children in their electoral decisions.
- We supplicate for those who have given themselves to the task, according to the direction of the Holy Spirit, to preach in the marketplaces, pray in the capitals of the 50 states of this nation and their territories. For protection, wisdom, boldness, joy, and great harvest.
- We supplicate for the intercessors of every state and territory of this nation, that they may awaken in supplication and spiritual warfare, with the direction of the Holy Spirit. Declaring with one voice the will of God, stand in the breach for this nation, and humble ourselves before the ALMIGHTY.
- Outsupplicatefor the education system in the U.S. and other countries.
- Supplicate for sound and complete teaching in the churches to protect us from false teachers.

Declarations:

- Supernatural wisdom amid changes in our nation and the world.
- Financial strategies and provisions to spread the gospel.
- Educational strategies for the church.
- Educational strategies for our children and youth which prepare them to excel during these times and to be light amid darkness.

Luke 11:33

“No one lights a lamp and puts it in a place where it will be hidden, or under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, so that those who come in may see the light.

Supplication 4 - One Spirit

Ephesians 4:1-6

As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

In our prayer of supplication, a dream was shared with us; "*There was a table set for the pastors that was taken over by a new family that had just arrived by invitation.*" The time has come when God will reveal to all equally. There will be times of change in our churches where God will prepare people's hearts and minds to receive the revelation preached and the church will receive accelerated maturity. God prepares us for unity in revelation, faith, understanding, sound doctrine, and worship for new members as of those we have long served. Just like in the parable of Matthew 20, in the end everyone gets paid equally.

Matthew 20:1-25 ... A parable of the owner of a farm who pays the workers who worked from the morning as well as those who came in later.

Repentance:

- We repent if, for reasons known or inadvertently, we have entertained false doctrines.
- We repent that we did not properly prepare ourselves in the word diligently to be approved as workers who need not be ashamed.
- We repent for having preferences among the brethren.

Acts 10:34 Then Peter began to speak: "*I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism.*"

Romans 2:11 For God does not show favoritism.

Galatians 2:6 As for those who were held in high esteem—whatever they were makes no difference to me; God does not show favoritism—they added nothing to my message.

Supplications:

- We supplicate for the ability and charity to joyfully welcome newcomers to the gospel.
- Supplicate for Joy in the Great Harvest of 2024
- Supplicate for peace amid leaders who will be confronted by the changes the Holy Spirit will be making in the churches.
- Supplicate for wise teachers with worthy testimonies.
- Supplicate for hunger for the truth, the word, and the desire to study the truth.
- Supplicate for unity among the true children of God of different denominations.
- Supplicate for the exiles of different denominations due to changes and apostasy. Wisdom and love to receive a harvest from those who did not stain their garments and are cast out of apostate realms and are now looking for a place to congregate.
- Supplicate for wisdom to care for the wounded and weary.
- Supplicate for discernment, to find and support ministries that truly preach sound doctrine.
- We supplicate for wisdom and compassion to receive and minister to those wounded by the agenda of social immorality, who will be coming to our churches in search of truth.

We declare the following according to ***Ephesians 4:13-24***,

until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed.

That, however, is not the way of life you learned when you heard about Christ and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

Supplication 5 - Psalm 122 - Pray for the Peace of Jerusalem

Psalm 122:6-9

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem:

“May those who love you be secure.

May there be peace within your walls
and security within your citadels.”

For the sake of my family and friends,

I will say, “Peace be within you.”

For the sake of the house of the Lord our God,

I will seek your prosperity.

Introduction:

In February 2023 God revealed to us of terrorist attacks that were hidden and about to be revealed after 6 months, while the world is distracted by the war in Ukraine. Just 6 months later, the attack on Israel was unleashed, and now terrorist dangers are announced in various parts of the world. On the other hand, this is to be expected, just as Christ prophesied to His disciples. Israel has already been revived (1948) as promised to the disciples, and that such a generation would not pass without these events taking place. Which events? Wars, rumors of wars, betrayals among the "so-called Christians," persecution of true Christians, and the gospel preached to the whole world. But Christ said, DON'T BE ALARMED, it won't be the end yet. (Matthew 24:6)

We have much work to do even though these events are fulfilled and we live during that prophesied time. One of the most important tasks of the Christian today is the prayer and supplication for the peace of Jerusalem. NOTE: Psalm 122 does not necessarily call for peace in Israel or the world, but for the peace of Jerusalem. Jerusalem is the future capital of the world. Although there are wars in Israel and the rest of the world, it is in Jerusalem that the strife begin.

Supplication:

- We call for peace in the city of Jerusalem and government decisions that promote peace.
- We supplicate for protection from the attacks on Jerusalem, protection for both Jews and Palestinians, as well as those who visit this place.
- An supplication for understanding and revelation to the figures of religious authority in Jerusalem. We ask for the revelation of the true Messiah who will make possible a harvest in Israel.
- Supplicate for our nation to maintain its favor toward Israel. For those who bless Israel will be blessed.
- Supplicate for us to be patient with Israel, even amid its stiff-necked, denial of the true messiah, and acceptance of the immoral agendas of this time. To maintain love and compassion for the city and nation chosen by God to establish His kingdom.
- Supplicate for a great harvest of Palestinians for Christ. 2024 will bring the arrival in Jerusalem of Palestinians who will receive the revelation of Christ and they will be spokespersons of the Gospel to the rest of the Islamic world.
- Supplicate for our brethren in Christ who preach and minister in Jerusalem, who today are persecuted by Muslims, Jews, and other so-called religious Christians. We ask for your protection, boldness, peace, security, and joy.

We declare according to Psalm 122:

- That we will rejoice with those who will say to us, 'We will go to the house of the Lord.' The new harvest in Jerusalem and in our countries.
- May we live in Peace, and love for the city of God, Jerusalem.
- That there will be peace within its walls, in God it will always be our strength.
- That we will receive God's welfare, as we seek favor over Jerusalem, and reap God's favor.

Zechariah 12:2-3

“I am going to make Jerusalem a cup that sends all the surrounding peoples reeling. Judah will be besieged as well as Jerusalem. On that day, when all the nations of the earth are gathered against her, I will make Jerusalem an immovable rock for all the nations. All who try to move it will injure themselves.

Supplication 6 Victory Strategy

Jude 20-2

But you, dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life. Be merciful to those who doubt; save others by snatching them from the fire; to others show mercy, mixed with fear—hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh.

Introduction:

The letter of Jude clearly presents to us the present condition of the church amid the world. It speaks of those who follow the way of Cain, and (for profit) follow the perversion of the prophet Balaam,

and those who reveal themselves in contradiction like Korah. He labels them as murmurers, complainers, those in their own desires, and those who take advantage of others.

Our strategy in such circumstances is: Build ourselves up in the Holy Faith, Pray in the Spirit, Hold on to God's love, hope, convince those who doubt, preach the gospel, and have compassion. It may seem difficult but in reality, it is the deepest PRIVILEGE and joy that a Christian can have.

Supplication:

- Supplicate for our faith to be confirmed on a personal level and in our spirit. For an unshakable faith. May the events that will test our faith be for strength, knowing that Christ Himself intercedes for us.
- We supplicate for the guidance of the Holy Spirit in our decisions, and in our prayers. A change in the way we pray, so that God Himself will put in us the supplication. The petition and our intentions will be God's.
- We supplicate that we may learn to keep ourselves in God's love. Against all murmuring, complaining, and animosity.
- Supplicate against all ideas of division, contradiction to truth, and distractions of the world.
- We pray that God will give us the strength to wait on Him. The patience of our Faith, in the assurance of our redemption. Not to grow weary, not to grow faint, but to go forward with NEW strength.
- We ask for the ability to convince the doubter. We ask for strategies to learn the true message of personal apologetics that makes us apt for every good work.
- A strategy for educating our children and youth in true and personal apologetics.
- Specific evangelism strategy of power and JOY. Not to grow weary and never see the work of the gospel as a burden, but to understand we are privileged.
- We ask for the ability, understanding, and capacity to have favor and compassion for the needy, the wounded soul, and to know how to heal them.

We declare the following According to ***Jude 24-25;***

To him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy—to the only God our Savior be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages, now and forevermore! Amen.

Supplication 7 - To be a Shield it is necessary to sharpen swords

Ezekiel 22:28-30

Her prophets whitewash these deeds for them by false visions and lying divinations. They say, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says'—when the Lord has not spoken. The people of the land practice extortion and commit robbery; they oppress the poor and needy and mistreat the foreigner, denying them justice.

"I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found no one.

Introduction:

God desires to hear the defense in the prayer of His children. He desires to hear and feel the compassion of his children, (*those who graciously give what they have graciously received*) just as he heard Abraham's defense for Sodom, and Moses becoming a shield and standing in the gap for the people who worshipped false gods in the wilderness. As he says that the prayer of the righteous avails much.

Amid false doctrines, false prophets, iniquity, apostasy, religious violence, contamination, and persecution of the saints, God prepares us for compassion, intercession, and the last chance for some of them to have a chance at salvation before the final separation of wheat and tares.

So, to understand the problem and to have biblical clarity of the situation of today's Christian requires biblical knowledge under the submission of a broken spirit in humility and complete surrender to God. This is the sharp sword, which is a double-edged slash that penetrates deep into the heart.

We cannot stand in the gap to intercede and pray on behalf of God's people and be a shield of protection without first being sharp swords.

Supplication:

- We pray for a spirit of holy worship, which brings about humility, change, holiness, and surrender.
- We pray for the healing of many wounded hearts among leaders, to position them for compassion and healing of others.
- We pray for healthy marriages, men and women of testimony, in health, and able to educate their children in the truth.
- We pray for the profound revelation of the truth (the Bible) in our lives to the point that it will transform us to be true doers in obedience.
- We pray for the ability to have compassion for those who wrong us, insult us, and hate us. May we have the ability to pray for them and stand in the gap for their condition.
- We pray that God will enable us not to rush to condemn the sin of peoples, communities, or individuals, but to supplicate for compassion first.
- We pray that we will learn to GIVE by grace compassion, forgiveness, help, care, and goodwill.
- We pray for a strategy of intercession, prayer, and specific revelation for countries, specific places, missionaries, and the persecuted church.
- We ask for ways to pray for compassion for organizations that promote abortion, teach immorality in schools, and strategize how to bring salvation to these places.
- We ask for compassion for the "Christian" organizations that walk in apostasy, knowing that the end time is approaching but among them some have not stained their garments.
- We ask to be transformed in the word so that we can stand in the gap for our sons, daughters, and family members who are not yet saved.

We declare according to Romans 6:1-4

What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? By no means! We are those who have died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with

him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

Supplication of Closure

Introduction:

In the face of adversity and danger, we will have victories, blessing, provision, and care from God.

When we least expect to see victory, we will see it. To focus us on God, God will remove distractions, limitations, and overcome all understanding to show us His peace.

The dangers posed by the U.S. presidential election will reverberate throughout the world. There will be rumors of civil war, but we will be at peace, God will hear our supplications. We will lack nothing, and we will be shields of peace to others.

We declare according to *Psalm 91*

*Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High
will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.*

*I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress,
my God, in whom I trust."*

*Surely he will save you
from the fowler's snare
and from the deadly pestilence.*

*He will cover you with his feathers,
and under his wings you will find refuge;
his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.*

*You will not fear the terror of night,
nor the arrow that flies by day,
nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness,
nor the plague that destroys at midday.*

*A thousand may fall at your side,
ten thousand at your right hand,
but it will not come near you.*

*You will only observe with your eyes
and see the punishment of the wicked.*

*If you say, "The Lord is my refuge,"
and you make the Most High your dwelling,
no harm will overtake you,
no disaster will come near your tent.*

*For he will command his angels concerning you
to guard you in all your ways;
they will lift you up in their hands,
so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.*

*You will tread on the lion and the cobra;
you will trample the great lion and the serpent.*

*"Because he loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him;
I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.*

*He will call on me, and I will answer him;
I will be with him in trouble,
I will deliver him and honor him.
With long life I will satisfy him
and show him my salvation.”*
